<p>Learner Preparation <i>What information should the learners be given prior to initiation of the case</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 24 y/o female with vaginal bleeding and back pain for 3 days. • If asked, mom thinks she might be pregnant but unsure of dates • Friend with pt states she has been using fentanyl off the streets

<p>Overall appearance <i>What do learners see when they first enter the room?</i></p>	<p>Mom is withdrawn and complains of pain, walks over to the EMS gurney when they pull up to the house and sits on it. Asks for pain medicine, turns over to her side and closes her eyes.</p>				

<p>HPI <i>Specify what info here and below must be asked vs what is volunteered by patient or caregiver</i></p>	<p>EMS must ask for HPI, do not give unsolicited –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Mom is pregnant but unsure of how far along, states “all I know is I haven’t had my period for a couple months”. *Further questioning may reveal that she has had a previous C-Section and all her pregnancies were premature, the longest one being delivered at 32 weeks. She has had 2 previous miscarriages prior to 20 weeks. * Friend with mother states she has been taking Fentanyl that she got “off the streets” and she smokes THC as well as cigarettes. * NKDA, No Rx * Prev med HX includes 3 c-sections and an oophorectomy but she is unsure of which side
